Declaration on substances in products manufactured by TDK Electronics Group according to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals ("REACH") and RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, Annex II, as amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863

Dear Sir or Madam,

To the present and best of our knowledge, and based on the information currently available to us from our suppliers, current products manufactured by TDK Electronics Group do not contain added substances of very high concern (SVHC) included in the REACH Candidate List as published by ECHA on 4 February 2026 above the applicable threshold of 0.1% w/w in the relevant article within the meaning of REACH Article 33, except for products listed at:

In addition to monitoring the REACH Candidate List, we monitor compliance with REACH Annexes XVII and XIV. To the present and best of our knowledge, no substances used by TDK Electronics Group are affected by applicable restrictions under Annex XVII. We ensure that all substances subject to Annex XIV authorisation requirements possess the necessary authorisation where applicable.

Products manufactured by TDK Electronics Group and defined as "RoHS-compatible" are compatible with the requirements of Article 4 of RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, including Annex II as amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863, and the corresponding national implementing provisions to the extent such provisions reflect the Directive.

"RoHS-compatible" defined products do not contain restricted substances above the maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials: 0.1% for Pb, Hg, Cr(VI), PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP, and 0.01% for Cd, except where an applicable exemption under Annex III applies.
